Technical Support to Facilitate the Social and Labour Market Inclusion of Third Country Nationals in Poland Including Those Persons Fleeing Ukraine

Objective

Main - to build the capacity of the Polish authorities to provide those fleeing war in Ukraine and applying for temporary protection in Poland with efficient and effective access to public procedures and services for social and labour market integration.

Specific - supporting national and local (voivodship) authorities in the development and implementation of reforms within the existing legal and institutional systems related to supporting the integration of third-country nationals in Poland, including those from Ukraine.

Outcomes

Outcome 1. Ensuring the effective social inclusion of third-country nationals (including those fleeing war in Ukraine) by improving the services provided by Centres for Integration of Foreigners (CICs) and local government institutions, as well as labour offices.

Outcome 2. Improving the capacity of the Polish authorities to streamline procedures for the identification and recognition of skills and qualifications of persons fleeing from Ukraine.

Outcome 1. Ensuring the effective social inclusion of third-country nationals (including those fleeing the war in Ukraine)

Review of the existing institutional structure and operational procedures of the CICs and develop recommendations for improving the CIC service delivery, taking into account the current crisis context.

Activities:

- Functional review of services provided by Social Integration Centres, with particular focus on the needs of refugees from Ukraine (in a follow-up to the evaluation of the AMIF project) → Report
- Capacity-building training to the CIC staff, local government representatives and other stakeholders. → Training programme, introductory training inclusive
- Developing recommendations to improve and maintain the CICs' operation → Action Plan



Outcome 1. Ensuring the effective social inclusion of third-country nationals (including those fleeing the war in Ukraine)

Tools to operationalise and consolidate solutions under the CIC framework

Działania:

- Mapping and review of additional institutional structures for integration
→ Report
- Strengthening intersectoral coordination structures at the voivodship level
→ Proposal for a coordination structure, including its terms of reference
- Development and dissemination of information materials
→ Information Package



Outcome 2. Improving the capacity of the Polish authorities to streamline procedures for the identification and recognition of skills and qualifications of persons fleeing from Ukraine.

Developing a roadmap to improve identification, validation and recognition of skills and qualifications of Ukrainian/TCN citizens in Poland.

Activities:

- Mapping of occupations and qualifications → **Report**
- Comparative analysis of qualification and skills recognition systems in Poland and Ukraine → **Expertise**
- **Analysis** of good practice.
- Review of the Polish legal system with the aim to streamline it for recognition of skills and qualifications → **Recommendations for legislative changes** → **Training**



Mapping of activities in support of refugees from Ukraine

Objective – capacity assessment of public and non-governmental institutions to implement measures for migrant women and other refugees in the context of the planned activities:

- analysis on how to improve the CICs' operation in the Opolskie and Wielkopolskie voivodeships and their potential to be introduced in other voivodeships;
- developing a proposal for a coordination structure for migrant activity at the voivodship level, taking into account, among other things, its potential for systemic and inter-sectoral cooperation

Respondents: voivodship, marshal and poviast offices, municipalities, social welfare centres, poviast family support centres, labour offices, non-government organisations, employers' organisations, other, e.g. cultural institutions, schools, a board of education.



Methodology

Research tool – **online questionnaire**

25 questions:

- Respondent's data;
- Areas of the support provided (18);
- Types of support in the selected areas (open-ended questions) ;
- Target groups (7);
- Area of activity (the voivodship level; the country level - Poland);
- cost of the activities conducted (given in ranges).

Number of the online questionnaires completed: **800**

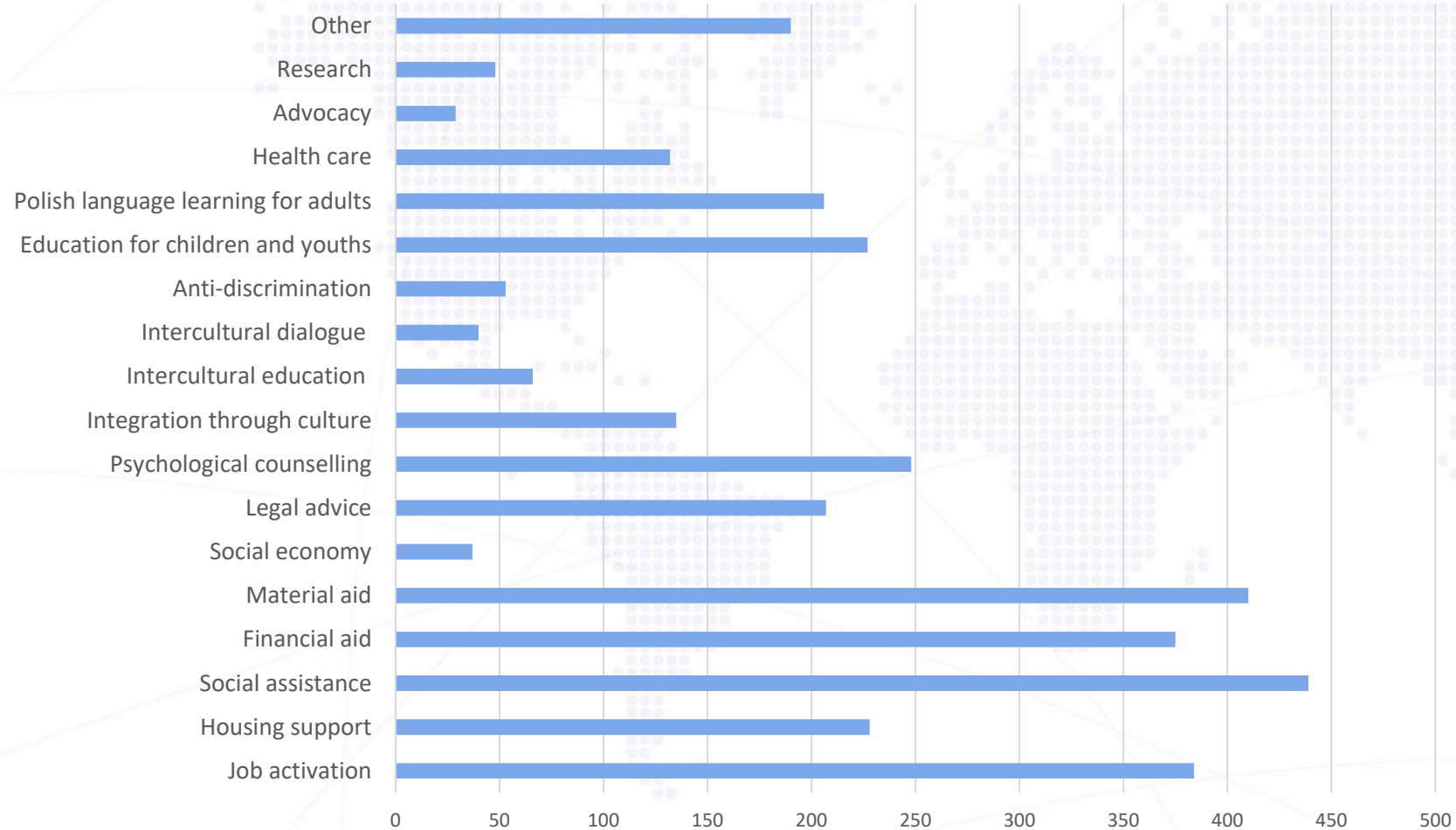

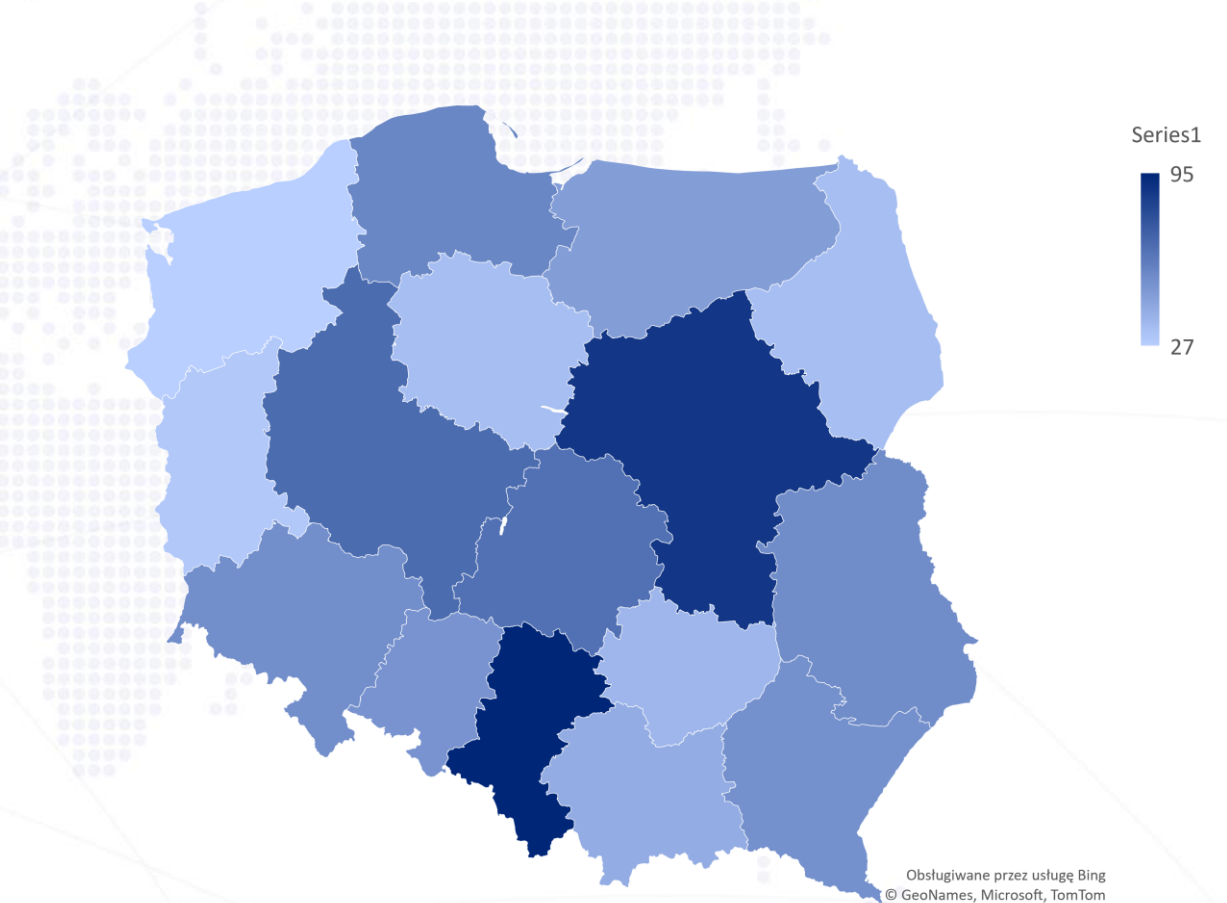

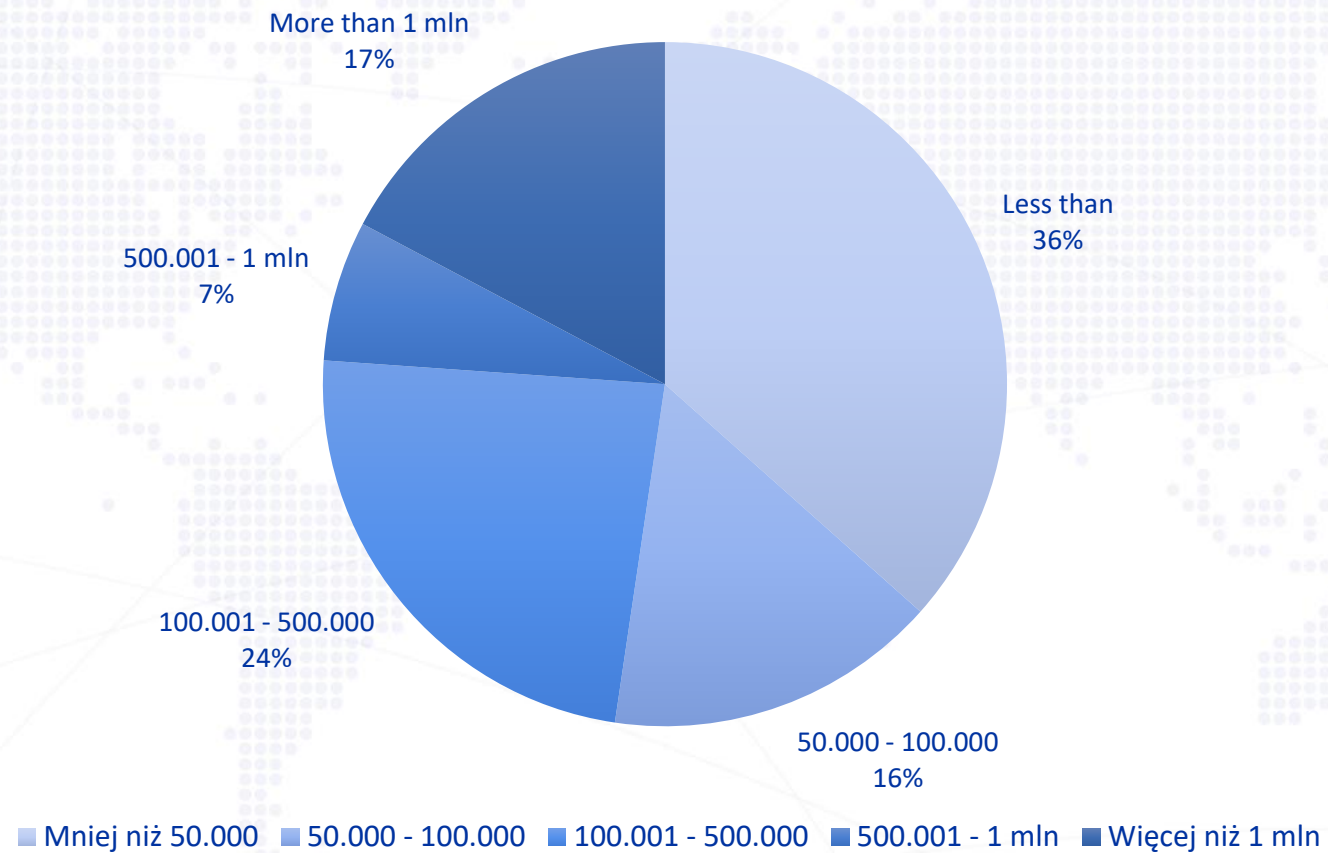

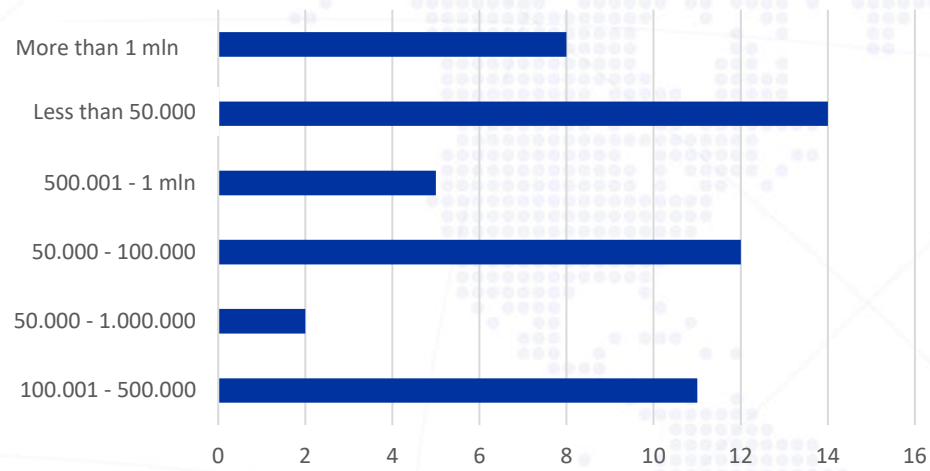

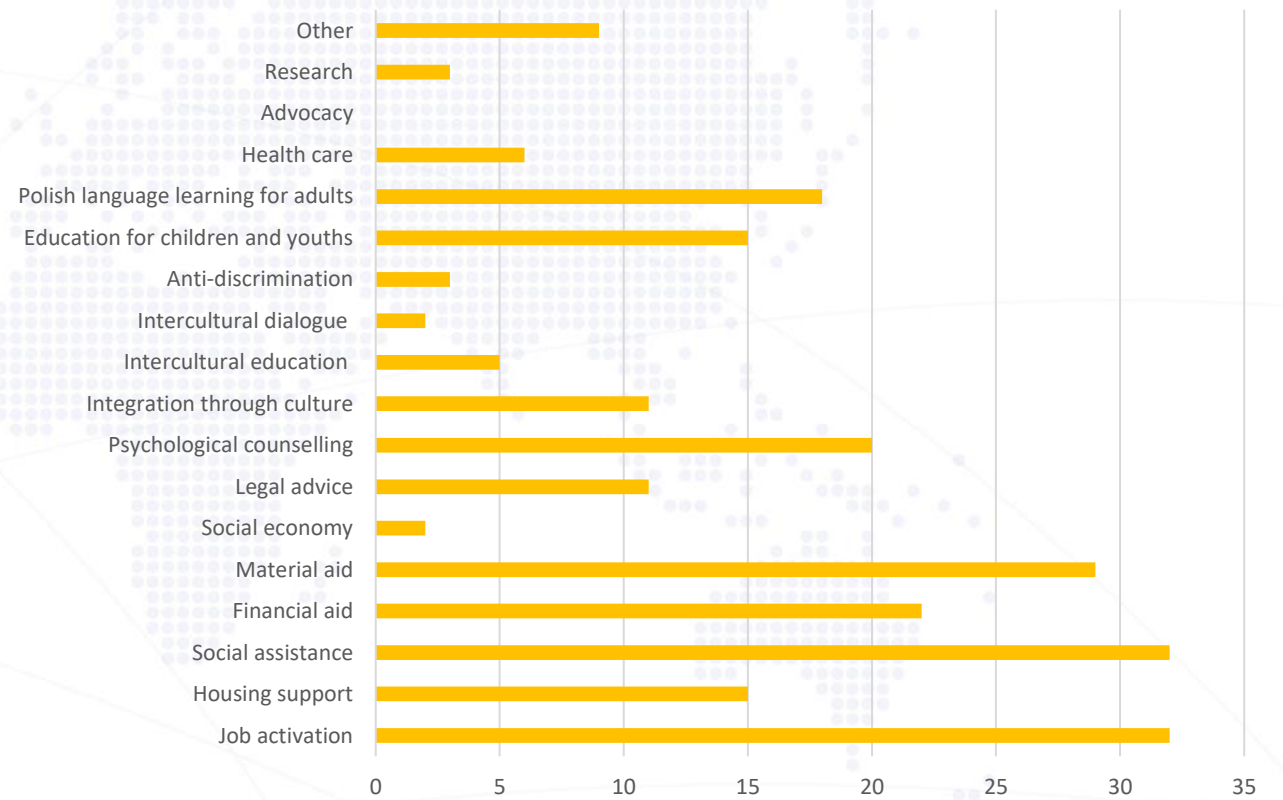


Dolnośląskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

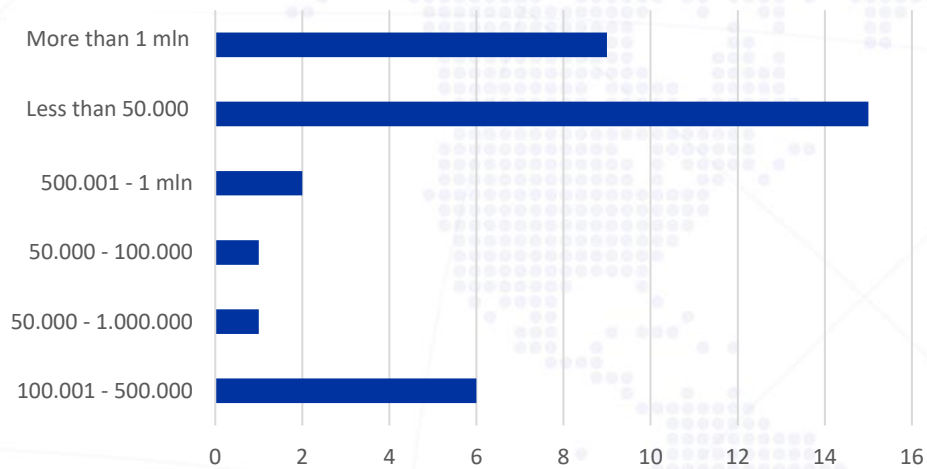

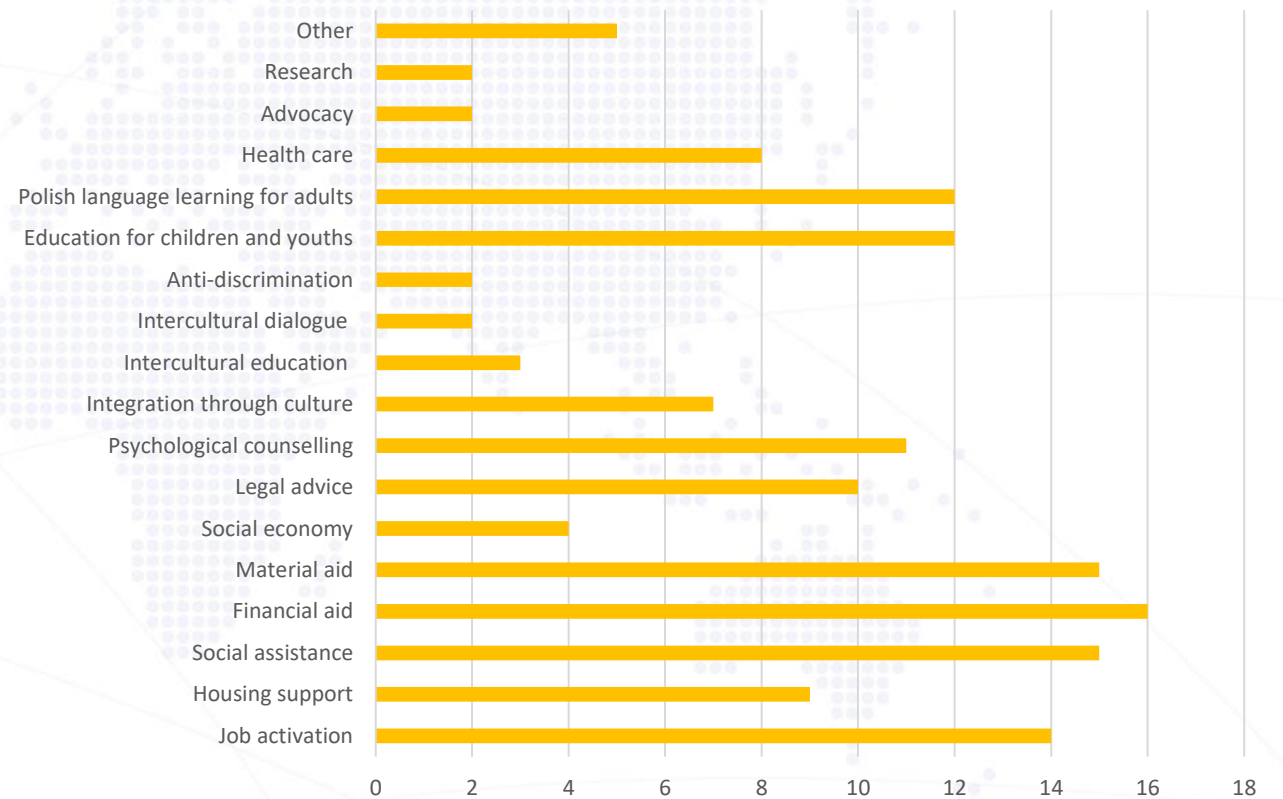


Kujawsko-pomorskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

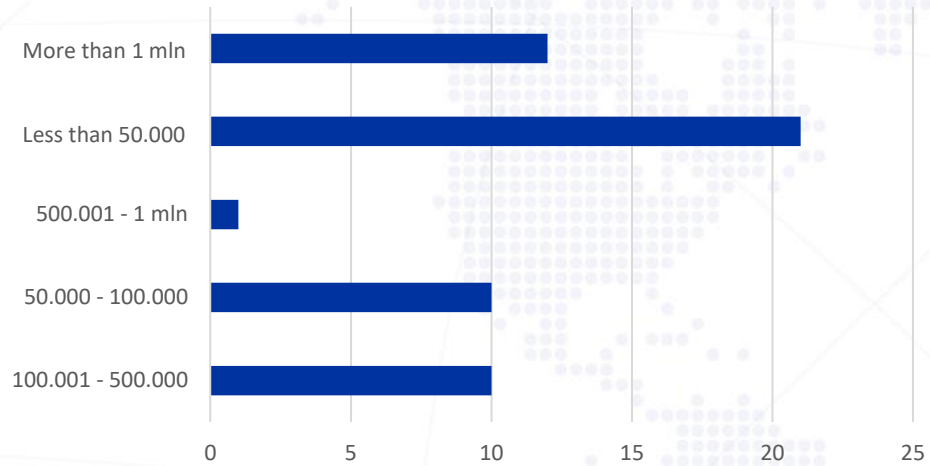

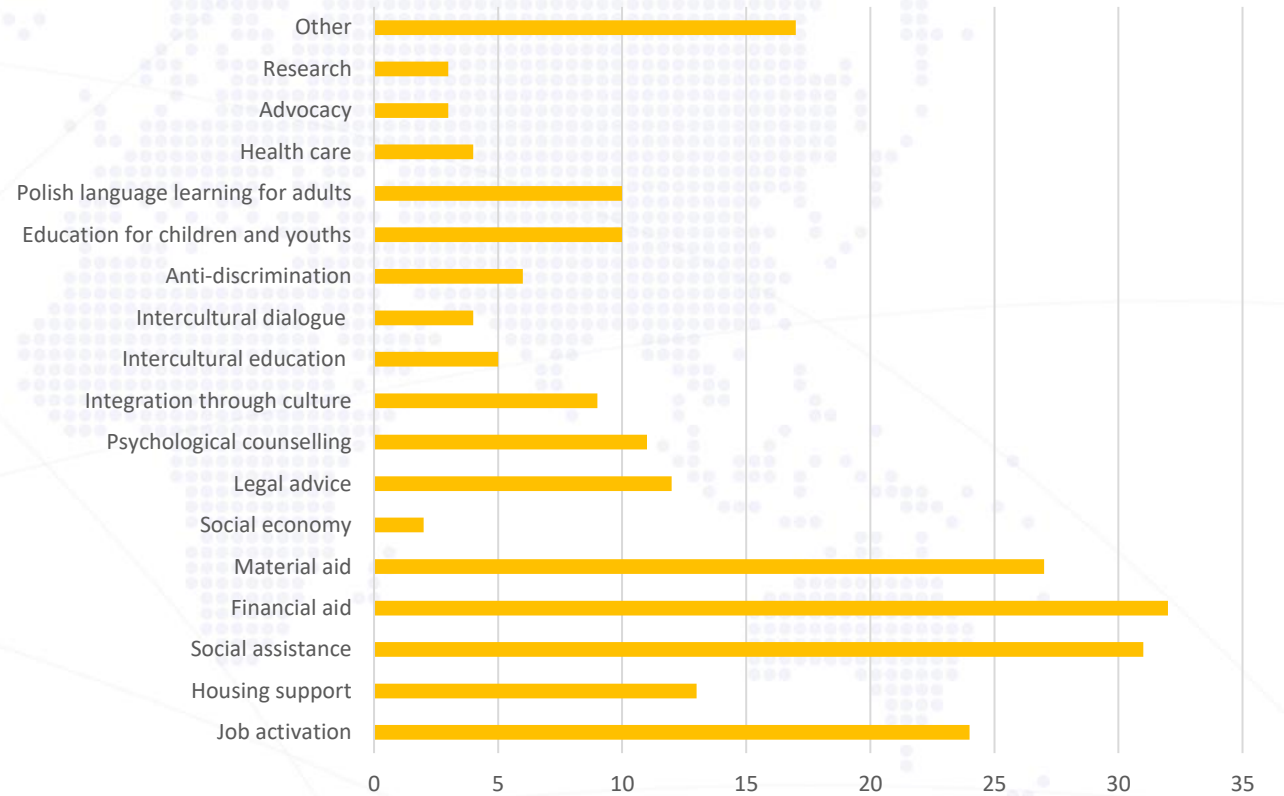


Lubelskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

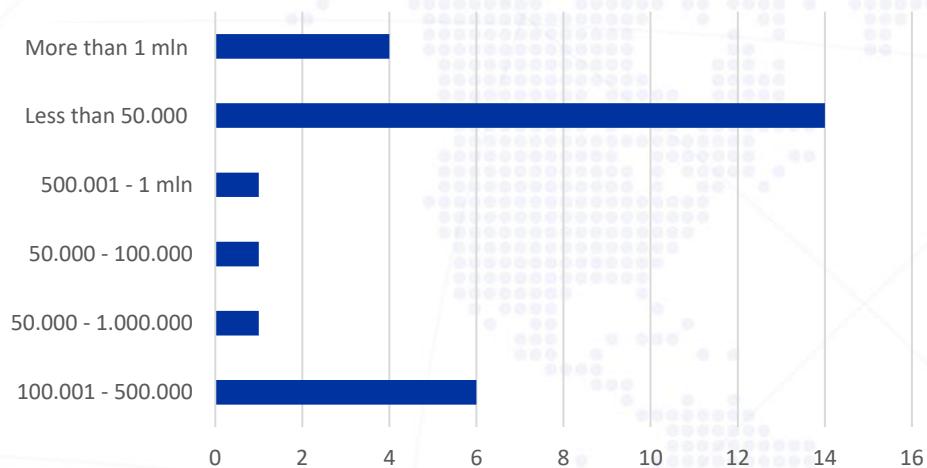

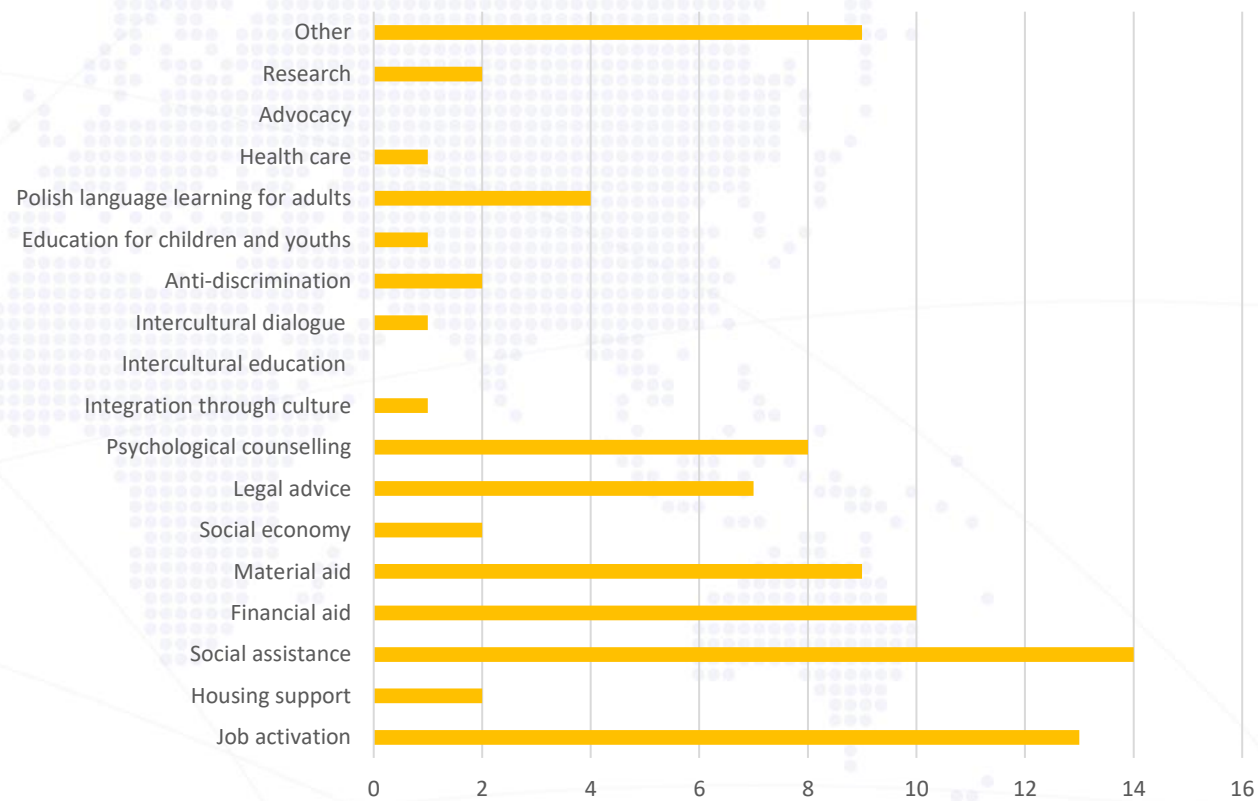


Lubuskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

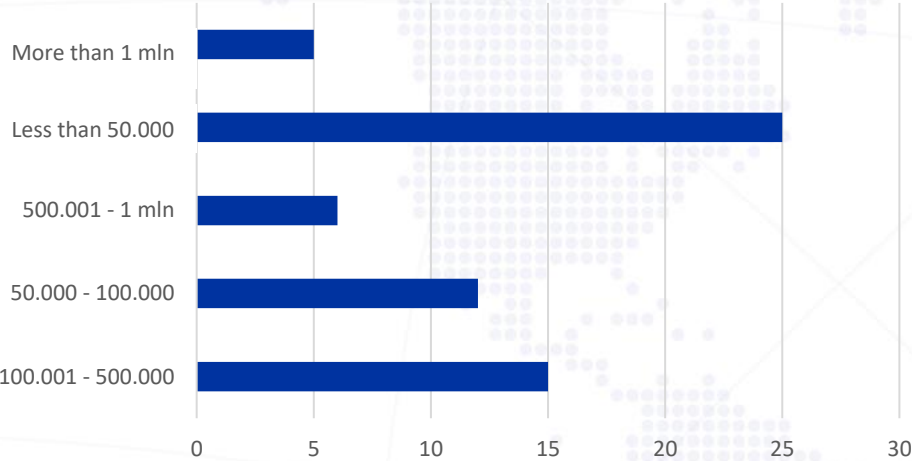

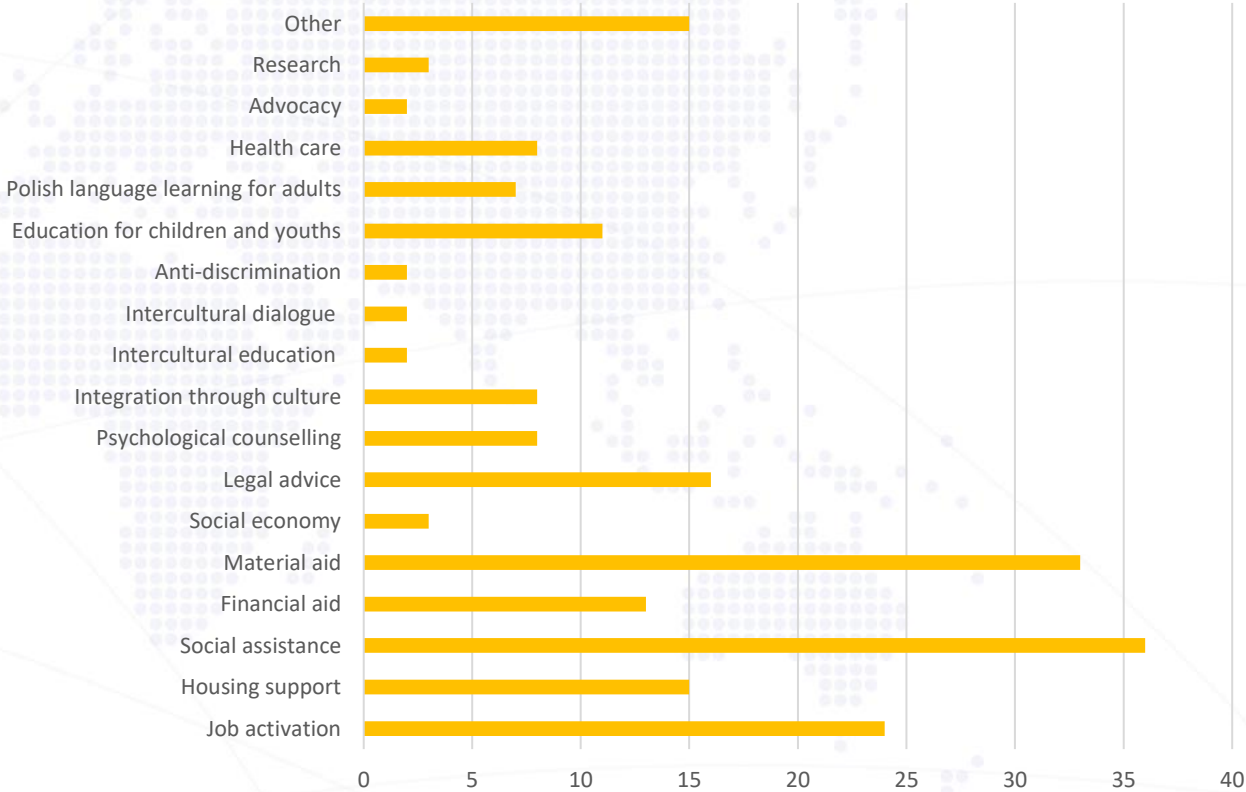


Łódzkie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

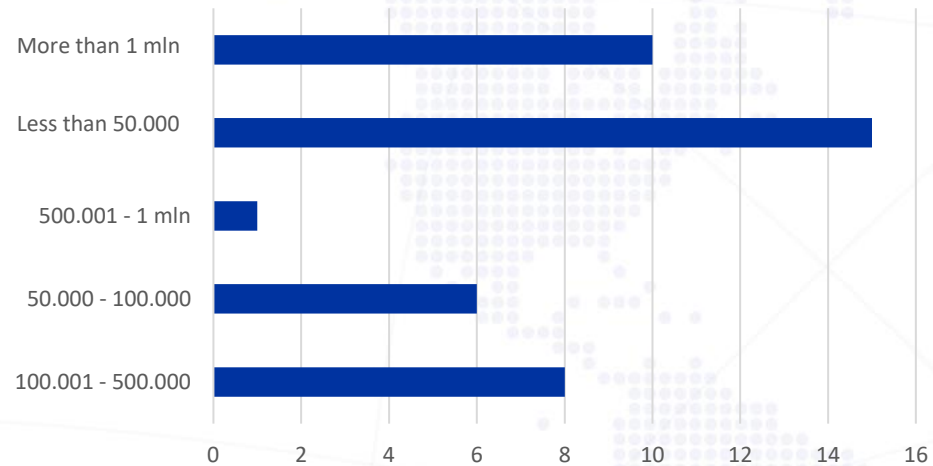

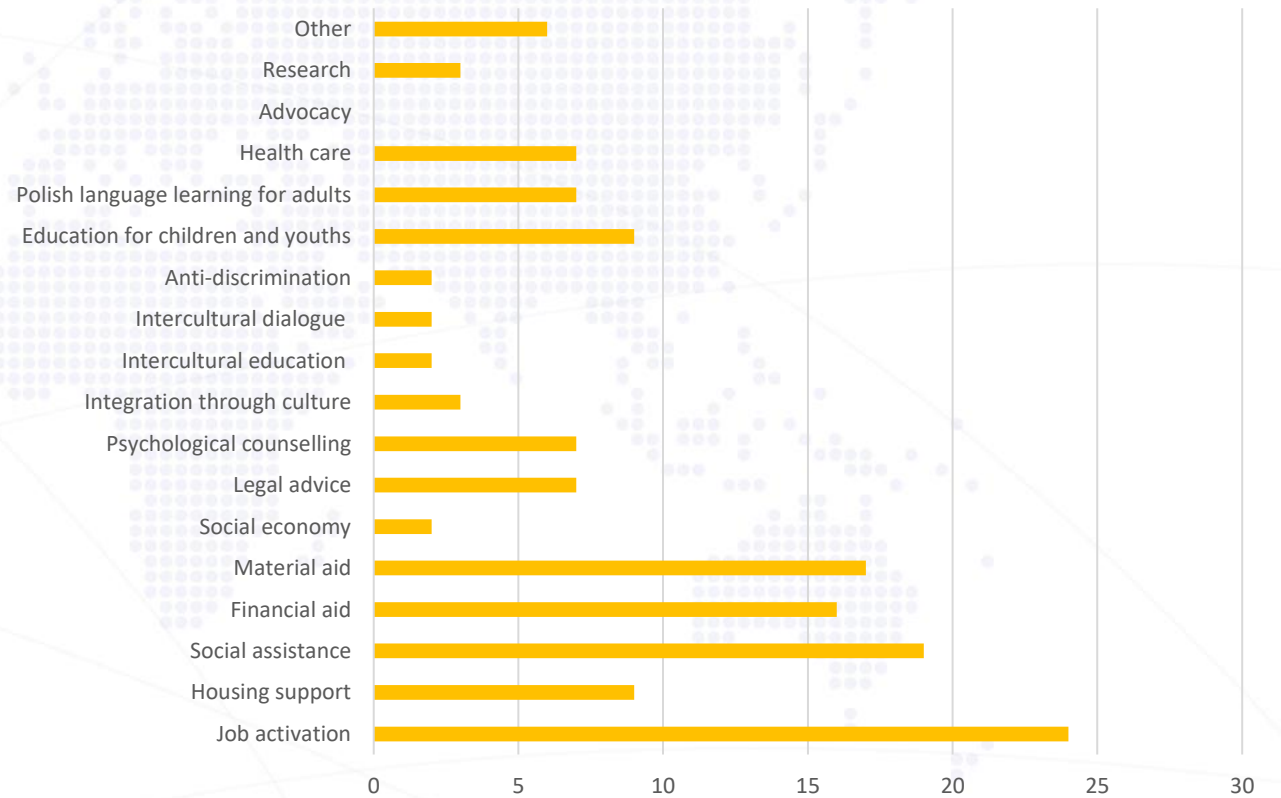


Małopolskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

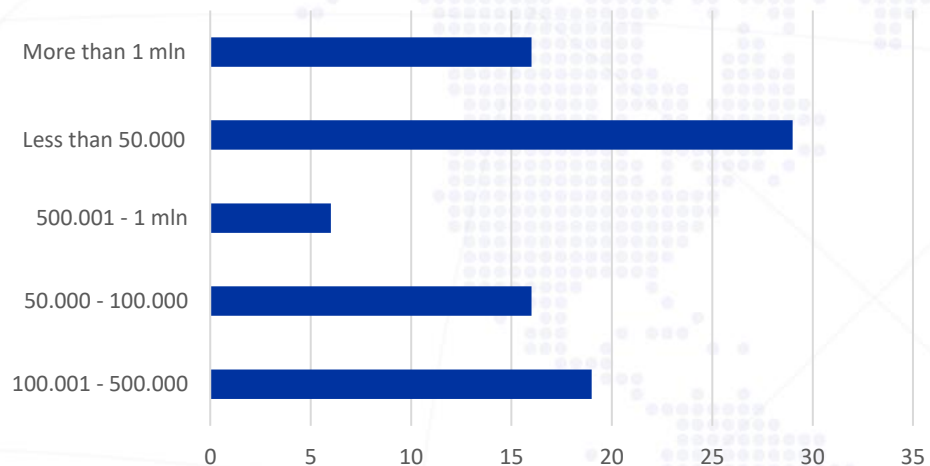

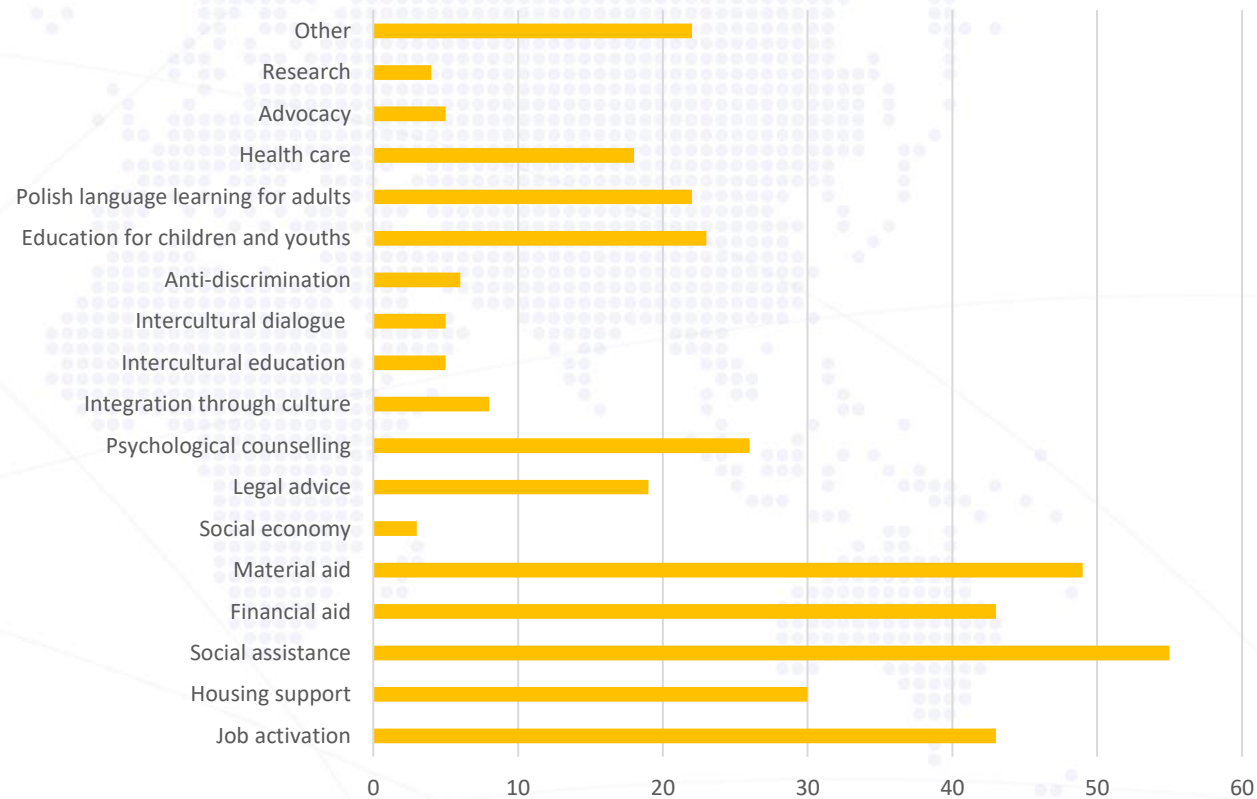


Mazowieckie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

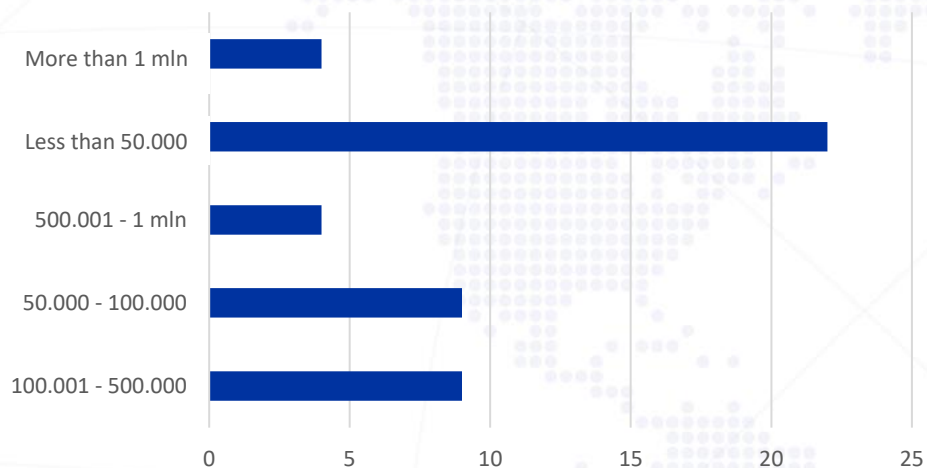

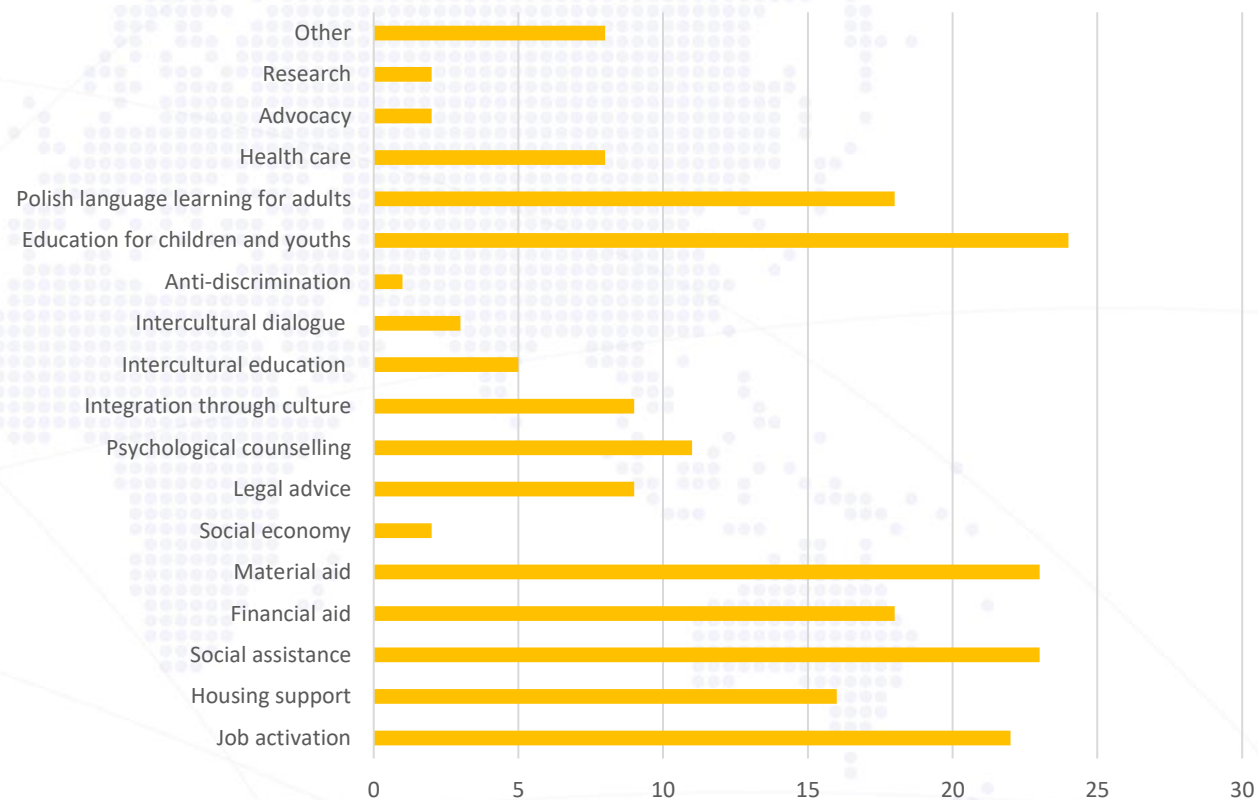


Opolskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

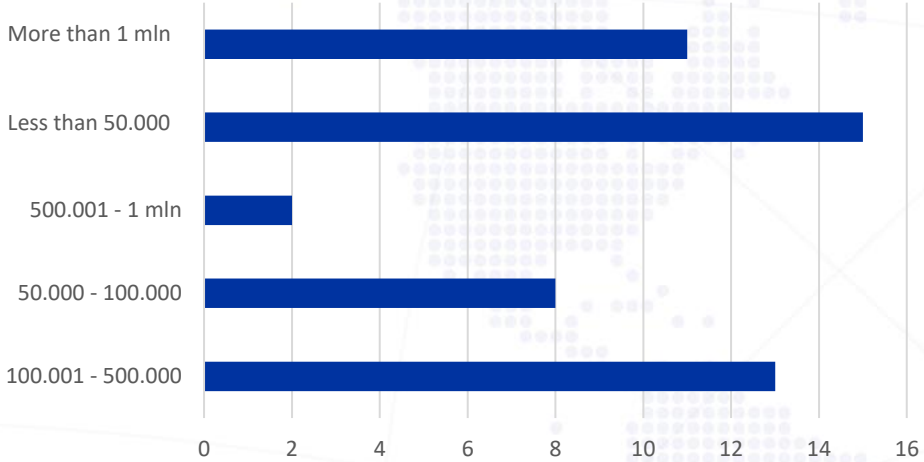

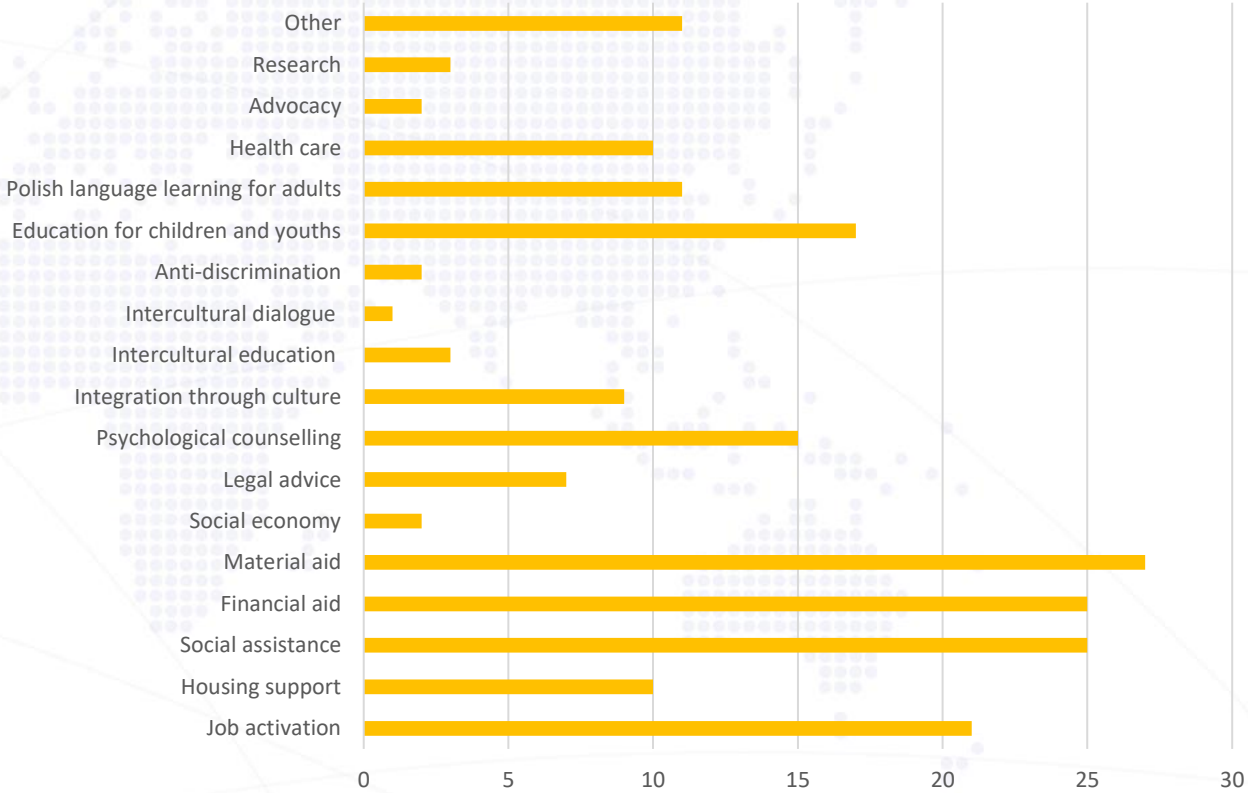


Podkarpackie

Costs of the activity conducted

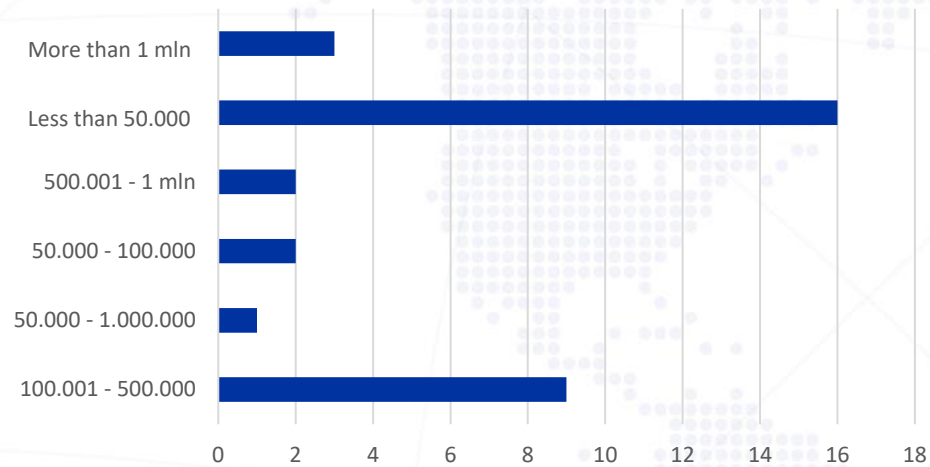

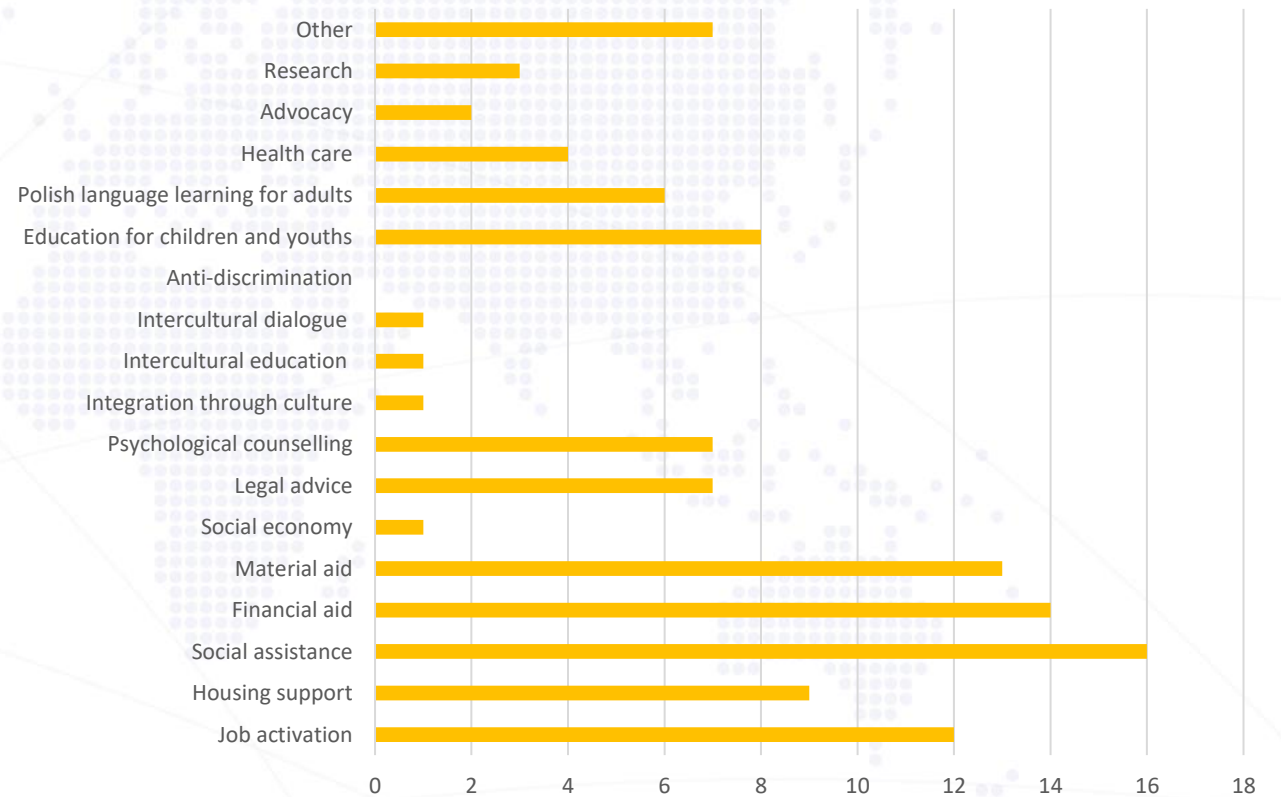


Podlaskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

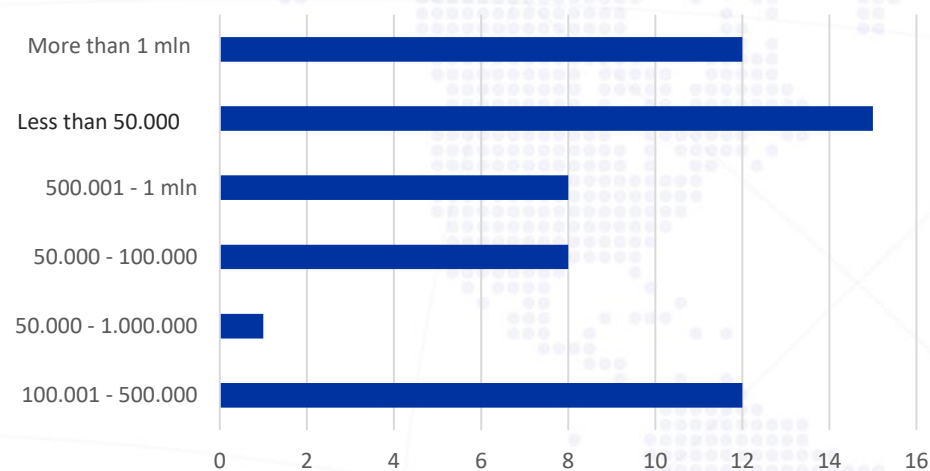

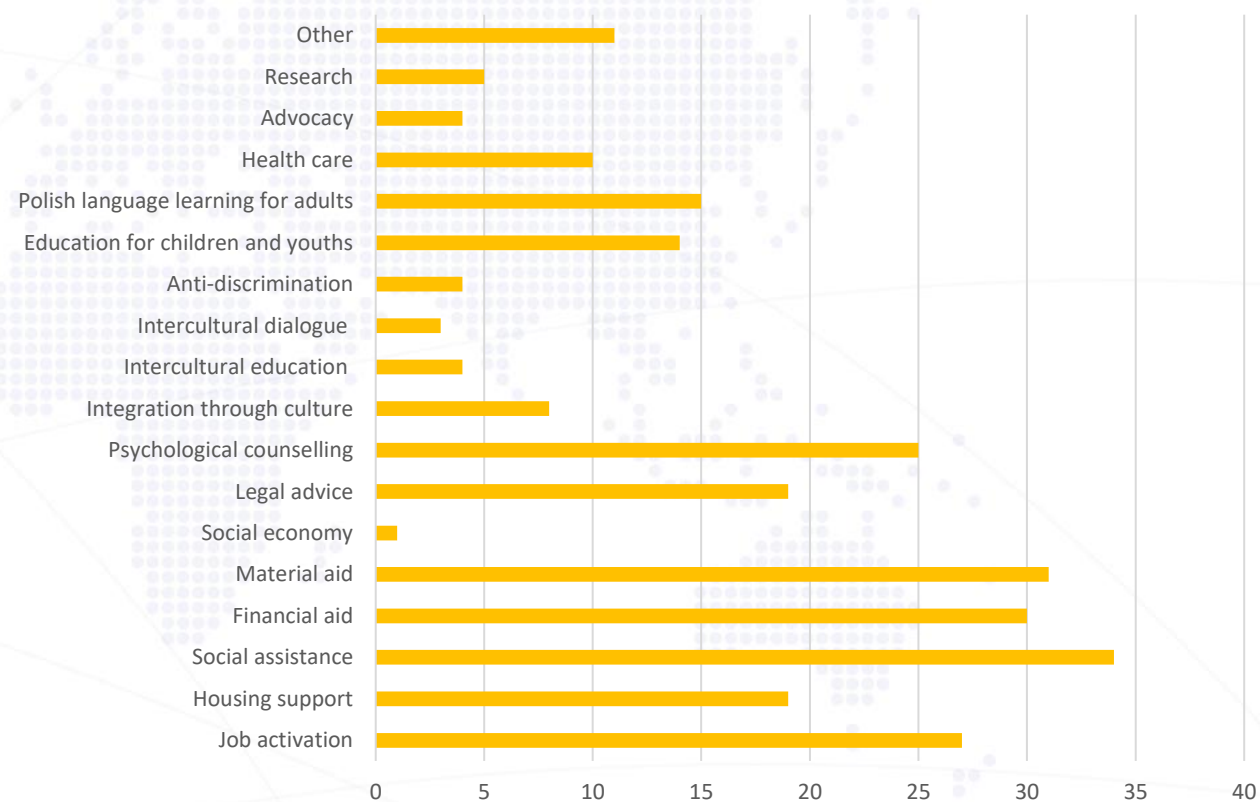


Pomorskie Voivodship

Koszt realizacji działań

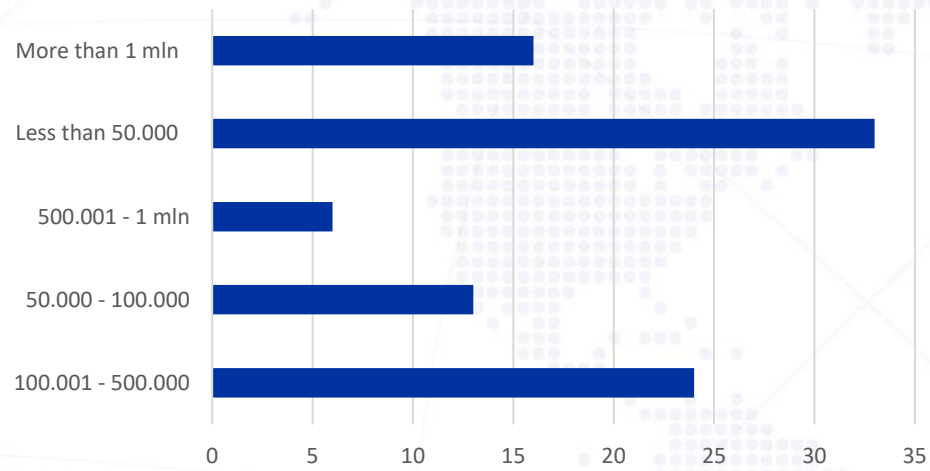

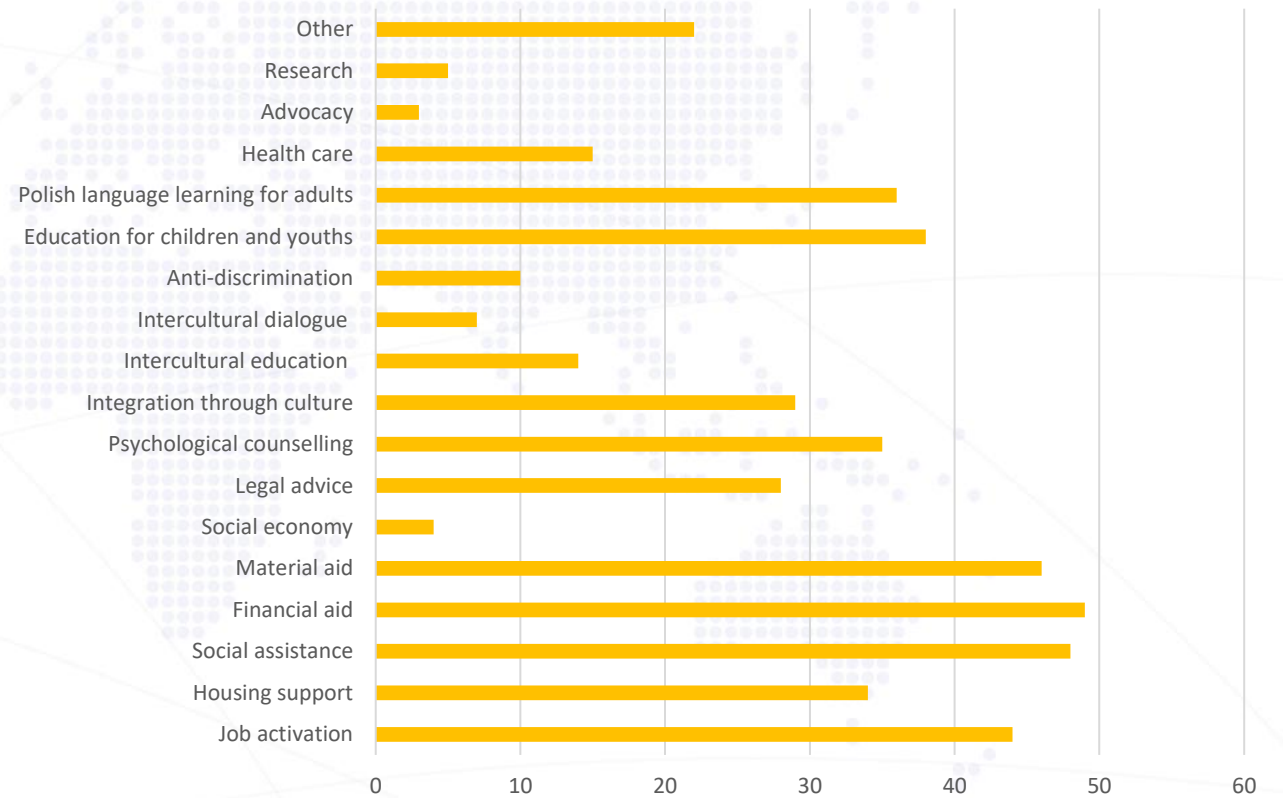


Śląskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

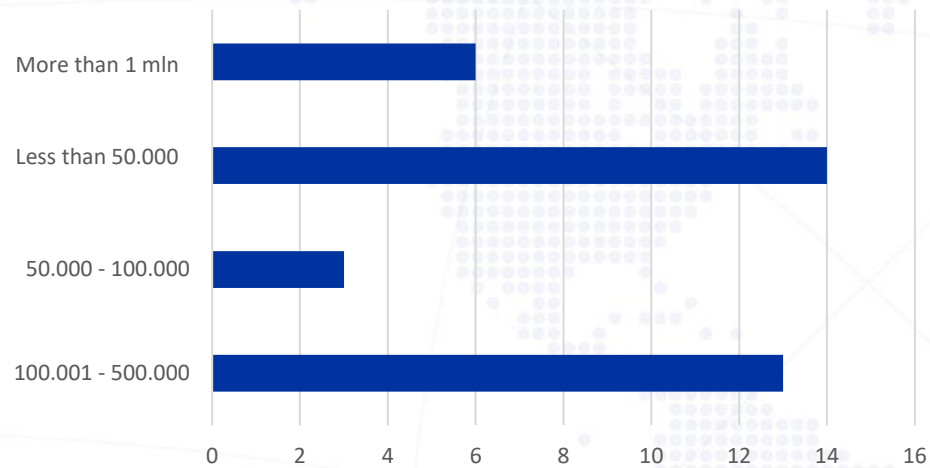

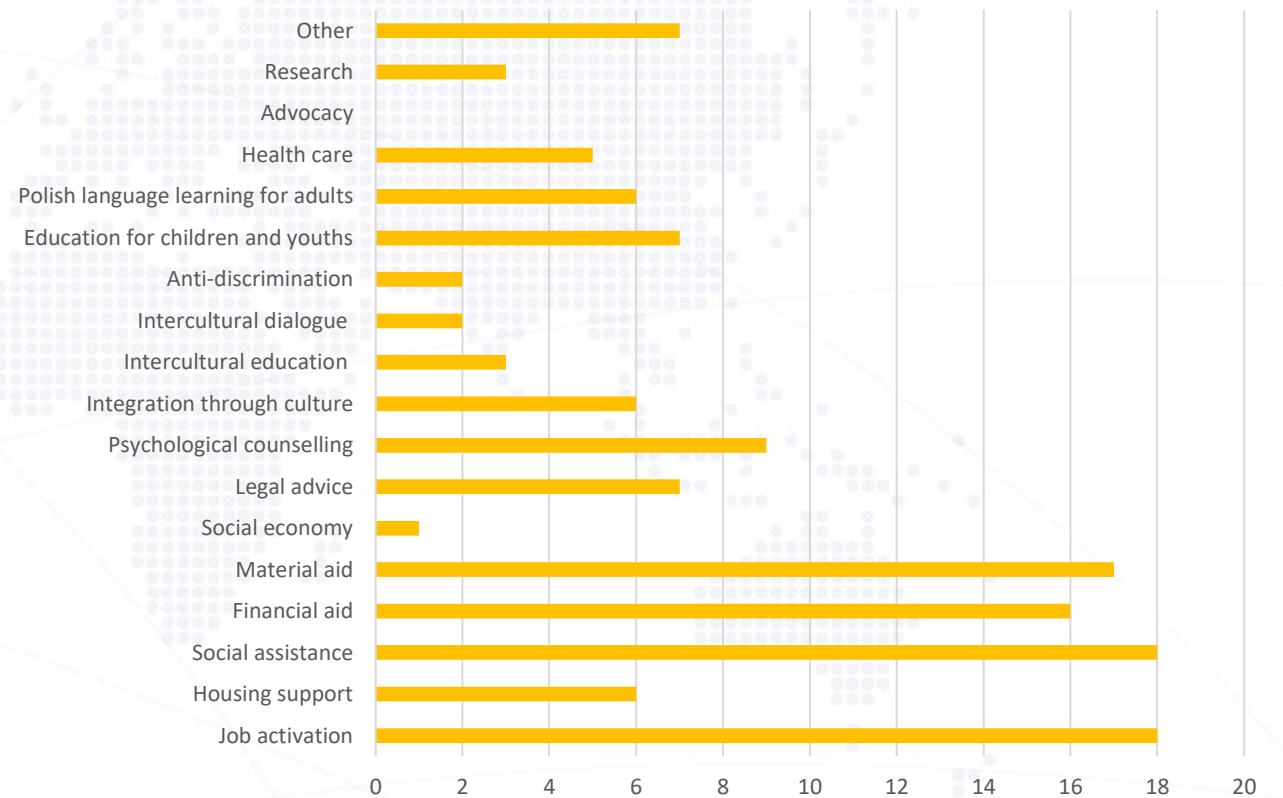


Świętokrzyskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

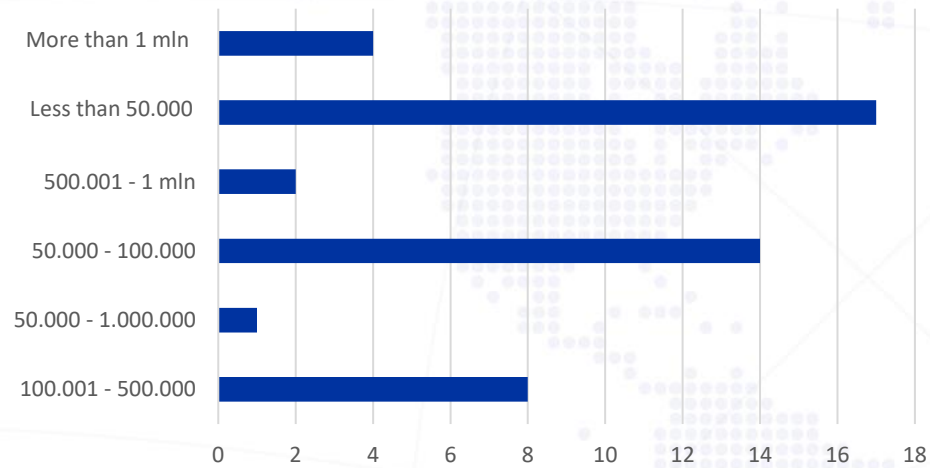

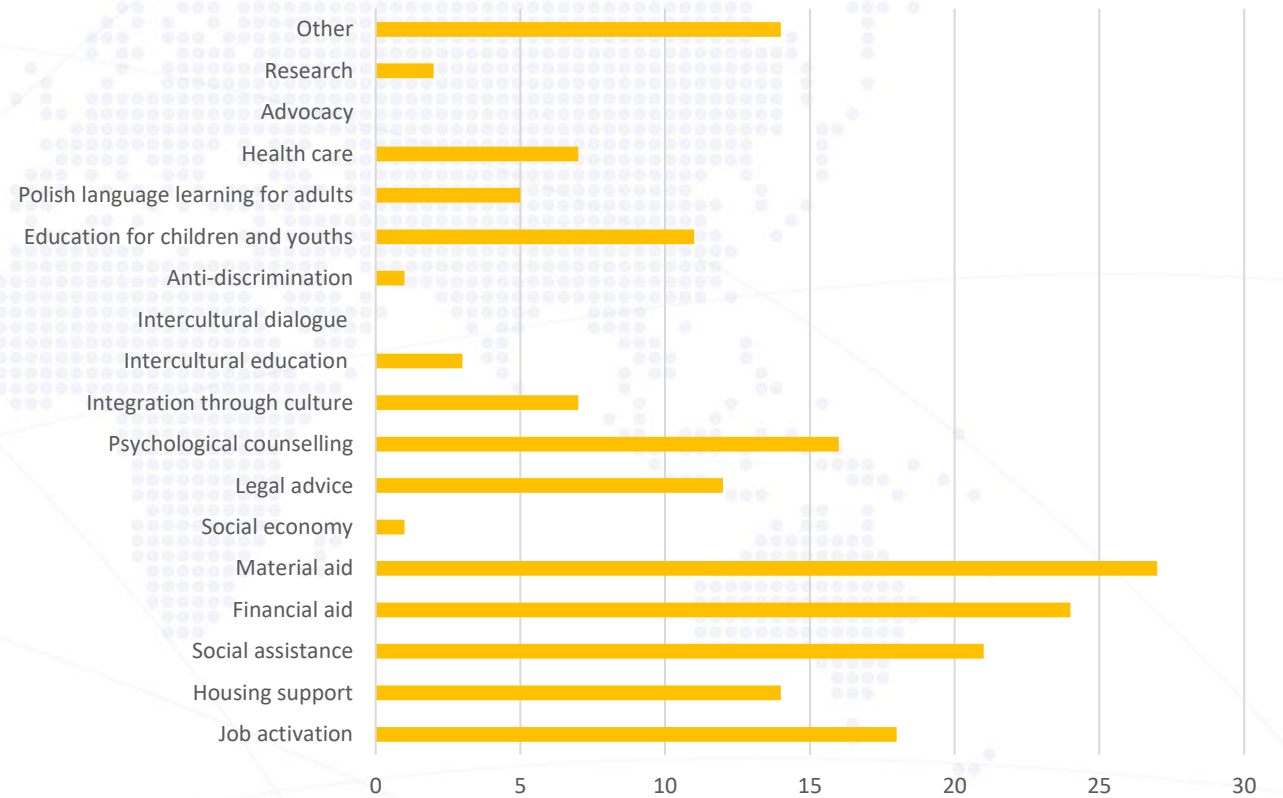


Warmińsko-mazurskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

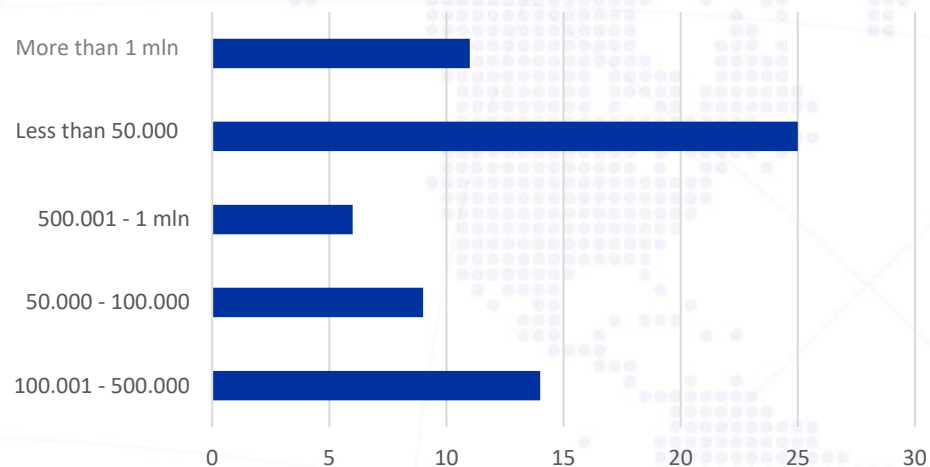

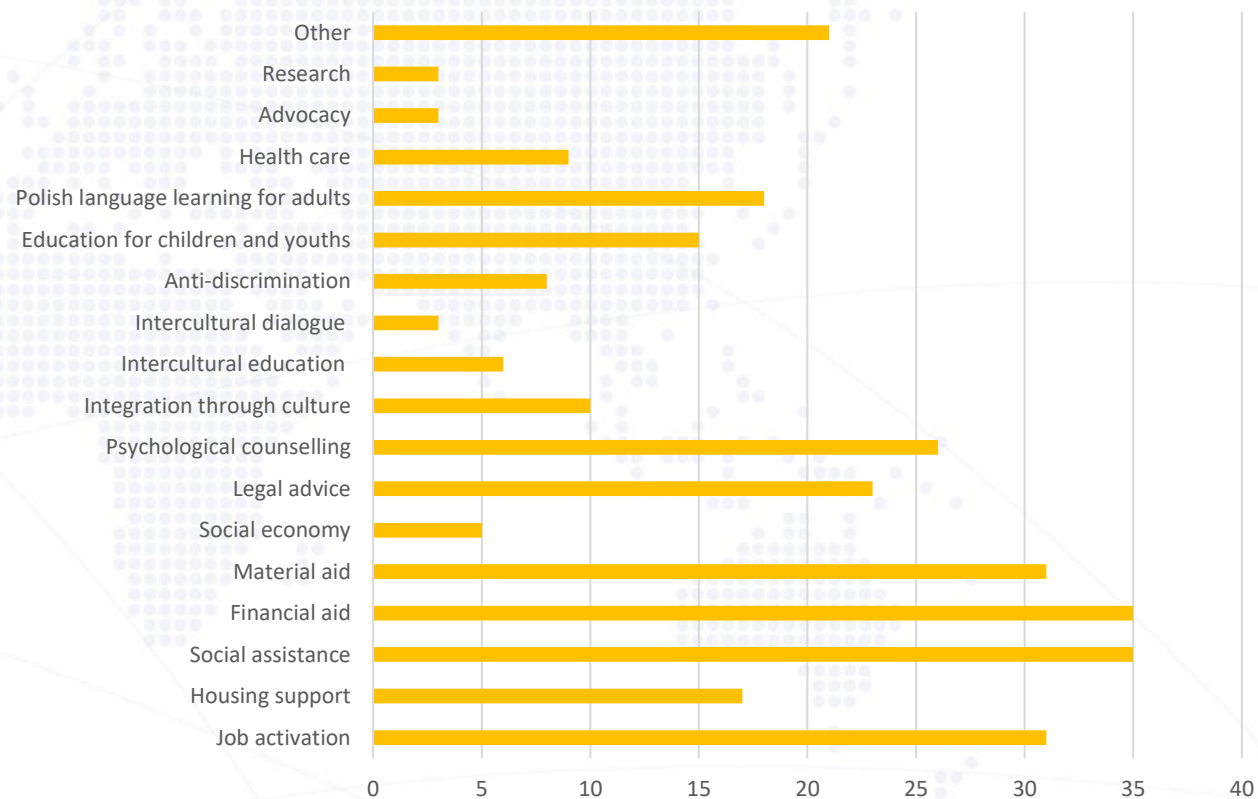


Wielkopolskie Voivodship

Costs of the activity conducted

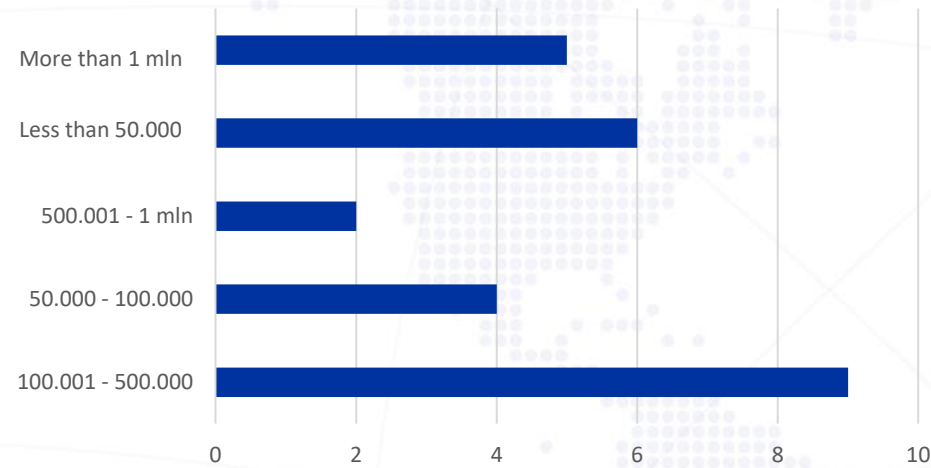

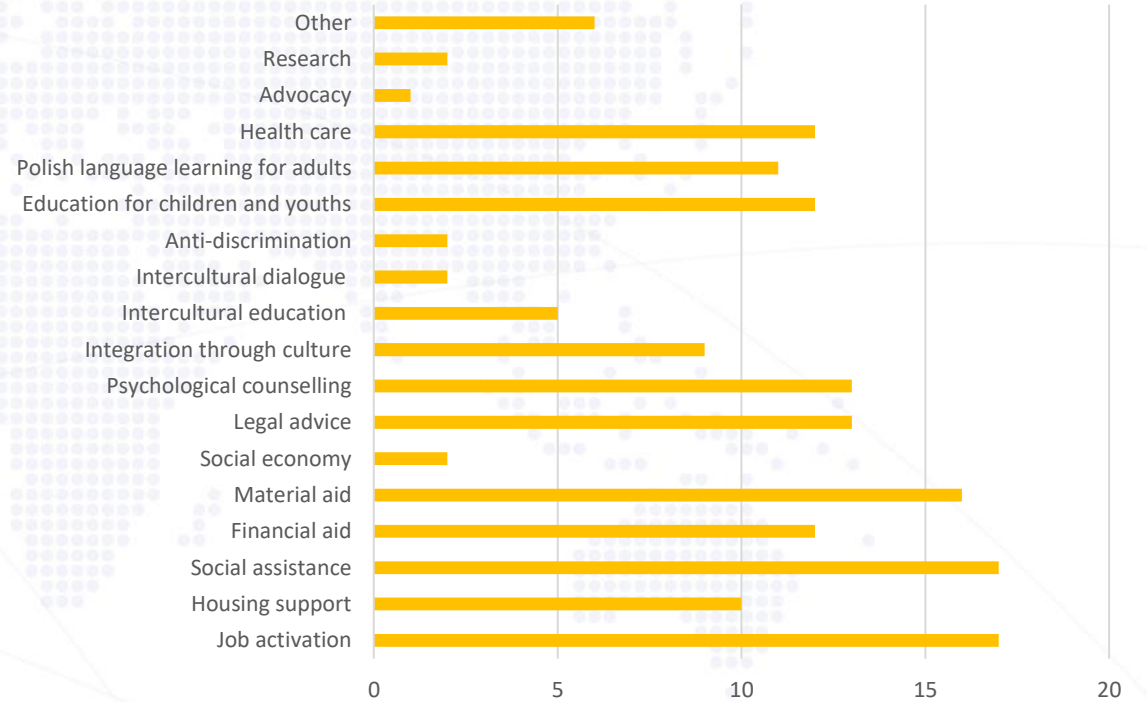


Zachodniopomorskie Voivodship
